Maybe, like my Father does, you put them out every day in early May and roll everything back into the garage every night! It works for him because everything he grows is in Containers, and in May, that is his job.

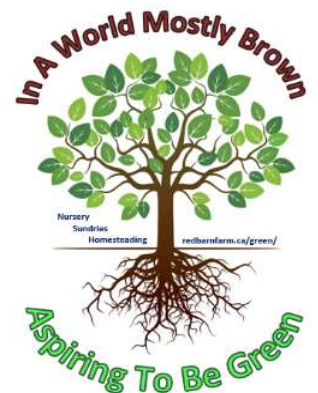
